CONSTITUTION

The Aims of the Association

- To enhance the social contact between parents at Crosfields School.
- Collectively to provide greater support for the School.
- **It will be no part of the Association's function to interfere with the academic, financial or administration policies of the School or to deal with any matters relating to individual children at the School.**

To achieve these aims the Association intend to:

- To continue to provide the parents of Crosfields School with the opportunities to meet socially.
- To bring a **STRONG** social spirit to the school.
- To provide a variety of events/ activities to meet the different needs of parents and to keep parents involved in the life of the school
- Aim to be the best at what we do.

Financial Aspects of the Association:

- Profit is NOT our sole objective but ensuring we meet all the above aims is our priority. Profit is merely a consequence of our success and should always be ploughed back into the school or donated to charity. This could also be used to subsidise other events organised by the CPA.

Membership of the Committee:

- The Committee will consist of The Headmaster, a member of staff and parent representatives from each school year. The position of Chairman, Treasurer and Secretary to be held by parents.
- Chairperson should be nominated by the committee and should have already served a minimum of 2 years on the committee.
- Treasurer and Secretary should be nominated by the committee and should have served at least 1 year on the committee.
- Parents members should give 1 terms notice to leave and should ideally be replaced by a parent from the same year group unless that year group is already represented.
- When parental vacancies arise on the committee, nominations will be made to the committee and final decision will be that of existing committee members.
- Re- election is after 1 year.
