

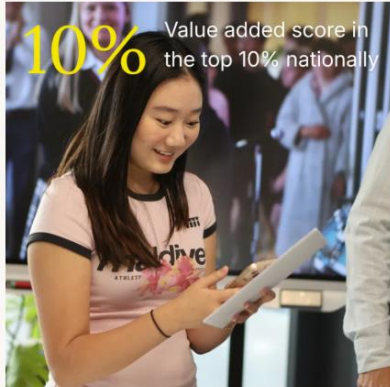

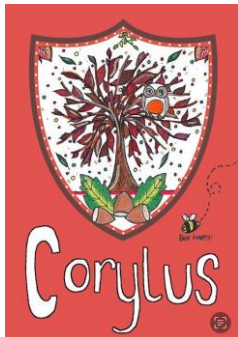

## Digital learning

Pupils in years 10-11 are currently enrolled on the "Bring your own device" program (BYOD) - *please see minimum requirements document: [BYOD-minimum-regs-Jan-26 .pdf](#) for more information.* Whereas pupils in years 7-9 are provided with a school managed one-to-one device with Windows OS and touch-screen functionality. All pupils have access to the Microsoft office 365 suite of applications, as well as Adobe creative cloud. When not in use, pupils are encouraged to store their devices securely in their lockers. Teachers may ask pupils to bring their device to any lesson across the curriculum, as required. It is therefore imperative that each pupil brings their device and charger into school every day.

## Mobile Phones

Crosfields Seniors is a phone-free environment. Every pupil in Year 7-11 is provided with a Yondr pouch and is required to have their phone locked in their pouch while on school site. If parents need to contact their child, they can call through to the school office who will then ensure that information is passed on.

## Trips

There are residential trips for Years' 7,8,9 included in the school fees.

- **Year 7** have a two-day, one night activity trip to Horseshoe Lake in mid-September which serves as a great ice-breaker where new friendships are made and the year group begin to gel. They have a second three-day two-night trip to Buddens activity centre in Poole that includes Sailing and a number of other activities.
- **Year 8** have a Monday-Friday trip to Bude Adventure in June after KS3 assessments, where they enjoy a programme of activities on and around the beach including surfing, SUP and lots more!
- **Year 9** have a languages and history trip to Normandy in the Autumn. Next year is the first year this has been run!
