YEAR GROUPS WITH AVAILABILITY

- Space available from Nursery (from second birthday) to Year 10.
- We will work with families of Year 11 pupils on a case-by-case basis, depending on subject alignment and examination requirements. Please rest assured that we will do everything we can to support families during this important time.

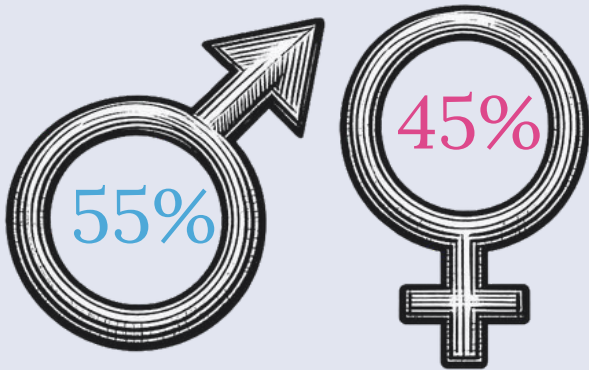

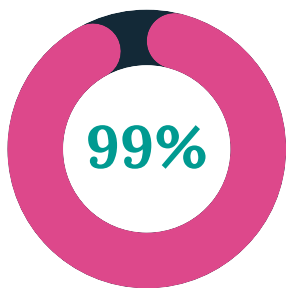

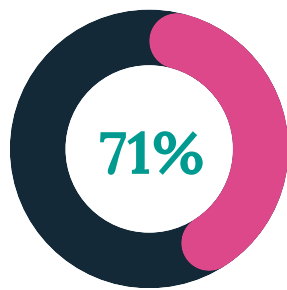
