Crosfields Fees for St Joseph's Families

Dear Parents and Guardians,

It was a pleasure to meet some of you and your families today. We recognise that this is a time of significant decision-making as you consider the next steps in your child's educational journey. We understand that choosing the right environment is both important and, at times, challenging.

Our foremost priority is to support families in making the decision that best suits their child's needs, aspirations, and wellbeing. With this in mind, I would like to assure you that, for the academic year 2026–2027, Crosfields has created a fee structure aligned with the fees published by St Joseph's School. Please note that our fees include compulsory additional charges which many local independent schools, including St Joseph's, do not include in their headline fee. Crosfields operates an all-inclusive fee model which comprises more than just core education. Our fees are inclusive of:

- Lunch, break and afterschool snacks
- Multiple curriculum day trips and workshops for all year groups in each academic year
- At least one residential trip per year from Year 2-Year 9
- Digital devices from Year 4 to Year 9 (Year 10 and 11 operate a bring your own device)
- Two highly trained nurses, a team of Emotional Literacy Support Assistants (ELSA) and a Mental Health Practitioner on site.
- Extended day care until 18:00 from Year 3 (an additional charge applies in Pre-Prep for extended after-school provision)

From our conversations with families today, we believe that St Joseph's families received several interim invoices. At Crosfields, your termly invoice will cover costs for the full term ahead. The only addition to this would be for termly extras such as additional "adventurous" residential trips and co-curricular hobbies which are run by external providers. These costs are invoiced in arrears at the end of each term. As a result, while our headline fees may appear comparable to those of other schools, including St Joseph's, our structure is designed to minimise unexpected or additional costs across the academic year.

We hope this commitment provides reassurance and flexibility, enabling you to focus on selecting the school environment where your child will thrive, without concern about financial disparity during this transition. We would ideally hope to extend this approach into the 2027/28 academic year. However, it would not be possible to make a firm commitment at this stage. Our intention would be to move progressively towards Crosfields' fee structure that reflects the breadth of educational provision and pastoral support provided for your children. As mentioned above, when considered on a fully inclusive basis, the overall difference in cost between the two models remains modest.
